Fathers Day

READ

Have a read of the stories below that show examples of different Fathers in the Bible.

NOAH (Genesis 6:6-10)

The Lord regretted that he had made human beings on the earth, and his heart was deeply troubled. So the Lord said, "I will wipe from the face of the earth the human race I have created—and with them the animals, the birds and the creatures that move along the ground—for I regret that I have made them." But Noah **found favour** in the eyes of the Lord. Noah and the Flood. This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a **righteous man, blameless** among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God.



ABRAHAM (Genesis 22:1-2 & 9-12)

Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac—and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you. When they reached the place God had told him about, Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood on it. He bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. Then he reached out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. But the angel of the Lord called out to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. "Do not lay a hand on the boy," he said. "Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son."

Create



Now that we have learnt about the different qualities of our heavenly Father, God, its time for you to get creative. Below is a craft you can make and give to your dad, grandparent or anyone who has taken care of you and loved you, this fathers day.

You will need:

- Colored card stock
- Washable paint
- Paper plate
- Baby wipes
- Pens or Pencils

Step 1- At the top of your document you will need to write 'Happy Father's Day to the best Dad'.



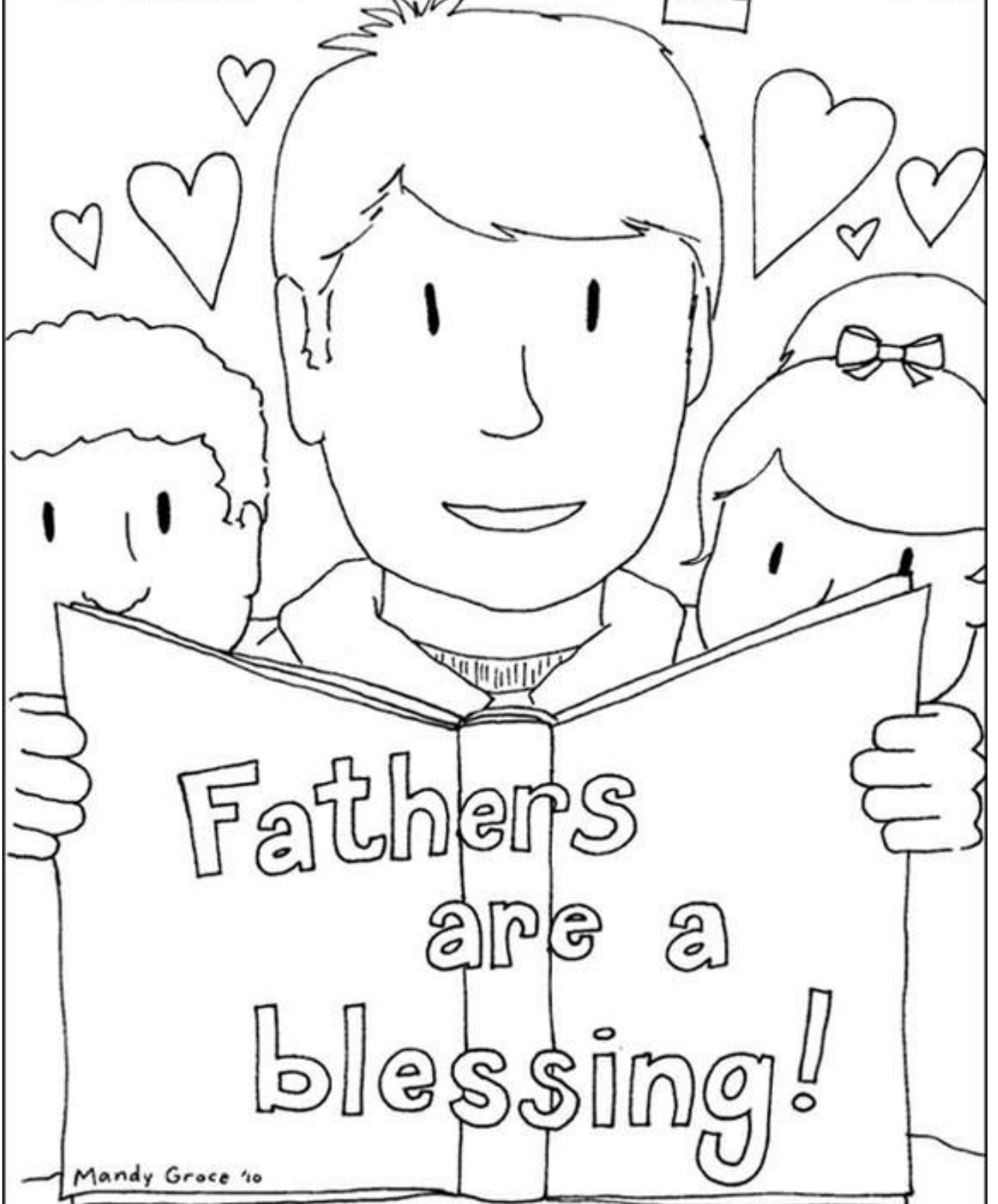
Step 2- At the bottom of the page you will need to write: '*Hands Down! Love (childs name)*'. You might want to pop a date on it aswell.

Step 3-Pop some of the washable paint on a paper plate. Holding your child's hand, place the right hand in the paint and make sure that the entire hand is covered. Immediately after getting paint on the right hand, place the child's left hand in the paint and make sure it is covered completely.

Step 4- NOTE: MAKE SURE THE PAPER IS UPSIDE DOWN WHEN YOU DO THE HANDPRINTS! Place the child's hand on the upside down paper and press them down, making sure their entire hand prints on are the paper. Set aside to dry.

Step 5- .Once the paint is dry, you can place the page inside a frame.
