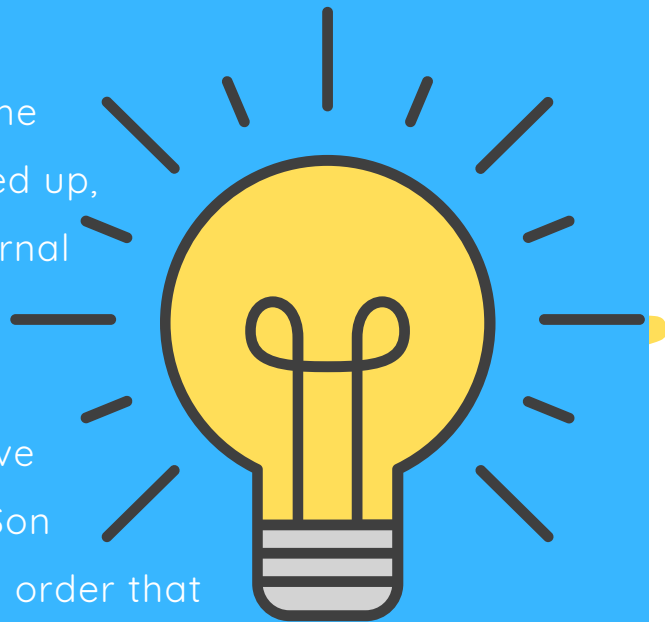

"How Jesus helps us see God"



And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life. - Have you ever played the game, “Made you look!”?

Here’s how it works – I point somewhere and say, “Look at those kangaroos! Do you see those kangaroos? And then, when you look over there, I’ll say, “Made you look!”

- What do you think – are you supposed to look or not look in that game?

You are right – you are not supposed to look. Because if you look that means you were tricked by the other person, right?

In today’s bible passage, we are reminded that who Jesus was and the things Jesus did were meant to “make you look.” However, when we look at what Jesus did, it is NOT because we were tricked...

...instead, Jesus invites us to look at his words and actions so that we can learn from him what living in God’s kingdom looks like AND so we would learn how to live in God’s kingdom just like Jesus does And the reason he did those actions and shared his teachings was because he was filled with God’s love – love that supports and gives life.

We are also reminded that when we look to Jesus and learn about God from Jesus, then we too will shine with God’s love and light. And, just like Jesus offered God’s love, healing, and forgiveness, we too are to offer God’s love, healing, and forgiveness Then, when we shine God’s light and share God’s love with others, we are helping them better see God, just like Jesus helps us to better see God!

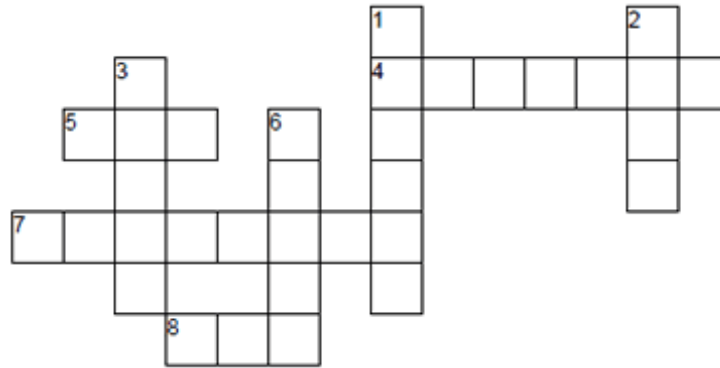




